

## COVID-19 Organizing a safe open house



Want to organize an open house? That's currently allowed, but it's important to respect these hygiene measures issued by the public health department:



Ask whether visitors have travelled recently or if they have any cold, flu or other symptoms. If so, take their contact information and plan a visit for later.



Minimize the number of people inside the home by letting in one visitor at a time when possible. The others can wait outside, maintaining a 2-metre distance from one another.



Avoid having children or people aged 70+ present.



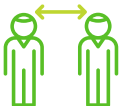
Ask visitors to wash their hands when they come in.



Open doors and cupboards and turn on light switches for visitors, to limit their points of contact.



Wash your hands between each visit, and disinfect bannisters and other contact surfaces.



Maintain a 2-metre distance from people at all times.



Wearing a mask is recommended but not required.
